

Earth Vs World

The Bible defines itself. “The earth” is the dry land.

Genesis 1:1 (page 1)

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

Genesis 1:10 (page 1)

And God called the dry land Earth; and the gathering together of the waters called he Seas: and God saw that it was good.

Typically, “the earth” and “the heavens” are mentioned together.

Ecclesiastes 5:2 (page 640)

Be not rash with thy mouth, and let not thine heart be hasty to utter any thing before God: **for God is in heaven, and thou upon earth:** therefore let thy words be few.

Deuteronomy 4:39 (page 189)

Know therefore this day, and consider it in thine heart, that the LORD he is God **in heaven above, and upon the earth beneath:** there is none else.

Besides the earth and the heavens, there are 2 more parts to God's creation. "Things under the earth,"

Philippians 2:9-11 (page 1098)

Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, **of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth**; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Exodus 20:6-7 (page 76)

Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is **in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath**, or that is in **the water under the earth**:

And "in the sea."

Revelation 5:13 (page 1153)

And every creature which is **in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea**, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and

power, be unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.

“The earth” is the dry land and “the world” includes the inhabitants on the earth. Inhabitants of the world are dwellers on the earth.

Isaiah 18:3 (page 663)

All ye **inhabitants of the world, and dwellers on the earth**, see ye, when he lifteth up an ensign on the mountains; and when he bloweth a trumpet, hear ye.

Psalms 33:8 (page 555)

Let all the earth fear the LORD: let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him.

Psalms 24:1 (page 551)

(A Psalm of David.) **The earth is the LORD'S**, and the fulness thereof; **the world, and they that dwell therein.**

Revelation 3:10 (page 1152)

Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation,

which shall come upon all **the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth.**

The world is the direct opposite of God. We must choose between being friends with the world and being friends with God.

James 4:4 (page 1133)

Ye adulterers and adulteresses, **know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God?** whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.

1 John 2:16 (page 1143)

For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, **is not of the Father, but is of the world.**

1 John 3:13 (page 1143)

Marvel not, my brethren, **if the world hate you.**

The prince of this world is Satan! That is why it is such an evil place.

John 14:30 (page 1005)

Hereafter I will not talk much with you: **for the prince of this world cometh, and hath nothing in me.**

The world doesn't know Christ.

John 1:10 (page 986)

He was in the world, and **the world was made by him, and the world knew him not.**

Christ came to save us from this present evil world.

Galatians 1:3-5 (page 1087)

Grace be to you and peace from God the Father, and from **our Lord Jesus Christ, Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world,** according to the will of God and our Father: To whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

1 John 2:15-16 (page 1143)

Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For **all that is in the**

world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

John 16:33 (page 1007)

These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. **In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.**
